Who is this module for?

Recommended* for anyone who needs a basic level of awareness of safeguarding, including but not limited to: licensed or lay – e.g. vergers, servers, welcomers, caretakers, refreshment helpers, shop staff, sidespersons, PCC members, bellringers, churchwardens, choir/music group members, employees of the DBE and DBF, other members of congregations, clergy, lay ministers, youth work interns

Intended learning aims and objectives

The aim of this module is to develop a basic awareness of safeguarding in the context of the Church and Christian pastoral care. By the end of the module you will:

- Be able to recognise safeguarding concerns
- Be aware of how to respond well to safeguarding information, including who to inform
- Be aware of when to make a record, what to include and the boundaries of confidentiality
