
CREATIVE PRAYER RESOURCES FOR THE CALL TO PRAYER

Praying as an Individual

Helping individuals join in the Archbishops' call to prayer can be challenging. This prayer resource is designed to help individuals join in the call to prayer. It has three sections helping people to pray for evangelism at three levels: praying for individuals, praying for your town, praying for our nation.

The prayer resource is meant to be doodled on, coloured in and scrawled on by the person who uses it, allowing them to customise and create something which helps them to pray.



Preparation

- Print out the template double sided—make sure it's the right way up. This can be done on any paper, but sometimes using recycled paper can give a texture to the paper which is more tactile. If you want people to colour it in, make sure you use white or lightly coloured paper.
- You need to fold up the sheet so that you can see the different sections. You can do this before you hand them out, or with larger groups, fold it up all together. Remember to give instructions slowly and repeat yourself.
- Folding instructions:
 - Place the piece of paper so that the map is in front of you.
 - Fold it from left to right and open it again. This makes a guide fold.
 - Fold the left hand edge into the middle of the page, using the guide fold you just made.
 - Fold the right hand edge to meet the guide fold you made.
 - Fold it from the bottom to the top and open it again. This makes a new guide fold.
 - Fold the bottom edge to the middle, using the second guide fold you just made.
