2. Nominations.

A nomination form for candidates appears overleaf. The form must be signed by a proposer and seconder, who must both be members of Diocesan Synod and of the same house as the candidate. The candidate must make a signed statement of consent, indicating willingness to serve on the committee.

- 4. In the event that there are more nominations than places for representatives of a particular house, a postal ballot will be conducted, and the results announced in time for the first meeting of the committee in 2019.
