NOTES

- 1. The Parish Share Appeals Committee was established by Synod at the time that the new system for Parish Share was approved in June 2005. Its purpose is to hear appeals from parishes over the levels of Parish Share that have been requested and, if deemed appropriate, to make adjustments to the allocations.
- 2. Nominations: A nomination form for candidates appears above. The form must be signed by a proposer and seconder, who must both be members of the same archdeaconry as the candidate. The candidate must make a signed statement of consent, indicating willingness to serve on the committee.
- 3. In order to assist electors in their choice, candidates may make short factual statements about themselves (e.g. previous service on Diocesan committees and other organisations) for inclusion in the voting papers.
- 4. In the event that there are more nominations than places for representatives of a particular house, a postal ballot will be conducted.
- 5. Any gueries regarding the procedure for election should be addressed to the Diocesan Secretary.
