Structure Governance and Management

The method of appointment of PCC members is set out in the Church Representation Rules. All Church attendees are encouraged to Register on the Electoral Roll and stand for election to the PCC.

Objectives and activities

St John's Alvanley & Manley PCC has the responsibility of cooperating with the incumbent in promoting in the ecclesiastical parish the whole mission of the Church, pastoral, evangelistic, social and ecumenical. It also has maintenance responsibilities for both church buildings.

Achievements and performance

Electoral Roll

There were 89 parishioners on the Church electoral roll, 39 of which are not resident in the parish.

Church attendance

The average weekly attendance counted during October 2016 was 36.

Churchwardens' Church Fabric Report

The Church Property Register and Church Log Book Register are available for interested persons to view, prior to being signed and accepted by the PCC.

The work undertaken during the last twelve months is as follows:-

All electrical cleaners and extension cables have been PAT tested.

Annual maintenance of fire extinguishers in both churches carried out in April.

Boilers serviced in both churches in December.

Valleys, gutters and downspouts cleared of debris at both churches.

Lock and bolt of cellar door repaired. Cellar light renewed.

Gable end of church repointed.

Electrical remedial work completed.

Organ tuned.

Porch light fitting renewed.

A handrail has been installed on the steps by the lych gate. This has been much appreciated.

The church is cleaned by Shirley McCue and her daughters. Thank you to all.

The churchyard has been well maintained by the Community Payback team and church members.

The font cover has been removed and placed to the left of the door to the organ loft.

Alvanley church has been open for two hours most Wednesday mornings and Sunday afternoons. This has been well received. Thank you Carole.

Gable end and stonework repointed. Gable end bargeboard repainted.

Secretary's Review of the Year

PCC Secretary's Review of the Year

Our PCC council once again met 6 times through the past year, currently we have 13 members: Reverend Canon Ray Samuels, Chair: Barbara Green, Churchwarden: Barbara Penketh, Assistant Warden: Shirley McCue, Treasurer: Diane Stredder, Assistant Treasurer: Beryl Orr, Secretary: Irene Moore. Other members: Andy Barendt, Douglas Cashin, Millicent D'Aulby, Carole Chandler, Annette Shaw, Juliet Compston.

Our role is to oversee the management and upkeep for both churches. Our stewardship over the year has been less than previous years due to not holding our annual Spring Fair. We are grateful to all those who help to organise and support our work through their giving in the current financial climate, rising costs and Parish Share place an increasing burden on our small community and fortunately we are well supported by both Parish Councils. Our main fundraising during the year consisted of Manley Garden Trail and online auction, both organised by Juliet Compston and plant stalls by Douglas Cashin together with a gift weekend and ride & stride event. The annual village charity fund also made a generous donation. Our thanks are also due to Shirley McCue for raffle fundraising and Carole Chandler for home made card sales both contributing to church funds. Diane Stredder, treasurer, has once again kept excellent control on financial matters and Beryl Orr acts as our assistant treasurer, responsible for bankings. Alvanley churchyard has again been very well maintained by the Community Payback Team, and Manley grounds maintained by Janet and Brian Haresnape.

A trial period of opening Alvanley Church on Wednesdays for two hours and throughout Sundays was agreed by the PCC. Grateful thanks to Carole Chandler who has volunteered to be present on Wednesday mornings. On Sundays church is left open for quiet reflection and prayer.

Our two churches require constant maintenance and grateful thanks to our Churchwarden and Assistant Churchwarden and other members involved. Our church services have been well attended, thanks to Reverend Canon Ray Samuels, assisted by Reverend Anne Samuels, and we thank them both for their support and encouragement and for the monthly group meetings 'Loose Ends' and Village Links which are hosted at the Vicarage. Congratulations were expressed to Ray Samuels on his appointment as Reverend Canon at Chester Cathedral. The monthly church drop in coffee morning at Manley Village Hall has proved to be quite successful and donations received, after expenses paid, have been forwarded to various charities.

Thank you to all who have supported us as we embark on another year of fulfilling God's mission.

Financial Review

Total receipts on ordinary unrestricted funds for the year ended 31 December 2016 were £30,880 (2015: £37,980) and are detailed in the Financial Statements.

£34,735 (2015: £35,596) was spent on providing the Christian ministry from St John's church, including the contribution of £19,692 to the Diocesan Parish Share (2015: £17,763), which provides the stipend and housing for the clergy. The sum that the churches in the deanery have to contribute is shared between churches according to a formula based mainly on the receipts of the parish.

The net result for the year on ordinary unrestricted funds was an excess of payments over receipts of £3,855 (2015: excess of receipts over payments of £2,384).

After adding bank and deposit account balances brought forward at the beginning of the year, the balance on all funds carried forward at 31 December 2016 was £22,045 (2015: £25,900).

Receipts were lower than the previous year as the Spring Fair did not take place, payments were very slightly lower than the previous year.

Reserves Policy

It is our policy to invest any surplus balances with the CBF Church of England Deposit Fund.

Independent Examiners Report to the Parochial Church Council ('PCC') of St John the Evangelist, Alvanley and Manley

This report on the financial statements of the PCC for the year ended 31st December 2016 which are set out pages 1 and 2 is in respect of an examination carried out in accordance with the Church Accounting Regulations 2007 ('the Regulations') and section 43 of the Charities Act 1993 ('the Act').

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

As the members of the PCC you are responsible for the preparation of the financial statements. You consider that the audit requirement of the Regulations and section 43(2) of the Act do not apply. It is my responsibility to issue this report on those financial statements in accordance with the terms of the Regulations.

Basis of the independent examiner's report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the General Directions given by the Charity Commission under section 43(7)(b) of the Act and to be found in the Church guidance 2006 edition issued by the Finance Division of the Archbishop's' Council. That examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the PCC and a comparison of the accounts with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the financial statements and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedure undertaken does not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view of the financial statements.
