1. Prayer

- Who could be involved?
- What are your next steps?

3. Gathering baseline data

- What information do you need to gather about: The life of the church? Project details?
 Other supporting documents?
- Who can help?
- Where will it be stored?

4. Fundraising mix

- What's the right fundraising mix for your church context, project, time factor?
- Who needs to be part of this discussion?
- Have you thought about ways to save money as well as raise money?
- What could you do differently?
