- Are there any trusts to call/email for clarification or advice?

- Who could help gather this research?

Wider context of a fundraising mix: grants, Christian giving, major donors and community and individuals (such as appeals and events)

- What's the right fundraising mix for your church context, project, time?
- Who needs to be part of this discussion?
- Have you thought about ways to save money as well as raise money?
- What could you do differently?
