

The earliest record of a church on this site dates from 1230, but nothing remains from the medieval church. The present building, which supersedes an earlier. smaller building, was extensively renovated and enlarged between 1861 and 1878. Only the outer walls of the two side chapels and the pillars of the South Nave remain from the previous 15th century building. The church is built out of local sandstone and was designed by the Manchester architect J. S. Crowther. James Fleet, a local man, was the builder.

This guide starts by the Font and leads the reader anti-clockwise around the church.
